### KŌKUA Needed - Class of 2019 - Project Grad!!

We need your kōkua! The Class of 2019 Project Grad (PG) committee is looking to recruit parent volunteers to serve at their PG location. Duties include, but are not limited to, receiving items from vendors for set up and monitoring equipment that will be dropped off at the venue. In addition, the 2019 PG committee also needs volunteers to be at the venue when vendors return to break down equipment after the graduates have departed.

The Class of 2019 PG committee needs parent volunteers at the venue (*\*the site will be disclosed closer to the actual event date*) from 9am – 8pm on Sunday May 26 **AND** from 6am – 9am on Monday May 27. They understand that the time commitment is long. However, the venue is requiring that a PG representative be present as long as there is vendor equipment on site. The time can be broken up into SHIFTS to look something like:

- Sunday, May 26
  - 9am-1pm (2-4 volunteers)
  - 1pm-4pm (2-4 volunteers)

- 4pm-8pm (2-4 volunteers)
- Monday, May 27
  - 6am-9am (2-4 volunteers)
- \*NOTE: Volunteers may also choose to cover multiple shifts and stay at the site for longer periods of time.
