How to Make a Yarn Lei

- 1) To make a yarn lei, you will need:
 - ✓ 1 skein of yarn
 - ✓ 3 straws from McDonald's
 - ✓ Tape
 - ✓ Scissors
 - ✓ Tape measure
 - ✓ A 7oz skein of yarn will make approximately 3-5 lei, depending on how tight you wind the yarn.
- 2) First, cut 3 base strings. Each string should be 54 inches long.
- 3) Next, thread each base string through each straw (one base string per straw).
- 4) Pull the yarn through the straw and overlap 1 inch of yarn on the outside of the straw.
 - ✓ SECURELY tape the overlapped yarn to each straw.
 - ✓ You want to make sure that the overlapped yarn does NOT loosen and fall off the straw during the lei making process.
- 5) Once all three base strings are securely taped to each straw, tie the ENDS of the three base strings together, leaving approximately 5" at the end.
- 6) Next, attach the loose yarn from the skein to the bottom of ONE straw by tying a knot.
 - ✓ You do not have to tie this knot too tight or securely because as the lei starts to come together, you will push the yarn OFF the straws.
 - ✓ The yarn from the skein will become the lei.
- 7) Hold all three straws in one hand, so that they form a triangle shape.
- 8) Begin by wrapping the yarn from the skein CLOCKWISE (or AWAY from you) THREE times around the straw nearest you.
- 9) Push the windings down on the straw.
- 10) Turn the straws in your hand CLOCKWISE, so that you SKIP the straw adjacent to the straw with the windings.
- 11) Make sure that the yarn from the skein passes IN FRONT of the skipped straw.
- 12) Continue wrapping the yarn from the skein CLOCKWISE (or AWAY from you) THREE times around the straw nearest you.
- 13) Continue this pattern of winding the yarn 3 times around a straw, pushing down on the windings and skipping the adjacent straw with the yarn passing in front.

- 14) As the windings start to fill up the straws, gently push the windings off the straws and down onto the 3 base strings.
- 15) REPEAT these steps until you have 44" of windings on the base strings.
- 16) Once you have 44" of windings on the base strings, cut the winding yarn, leaving about 5" at the end.
- 17) Carefully REMOVE the straws ONE at a time from the base strings.
- 18) Be careful NOT to allow the yarn from the straws to be lost in the windings.
- 19) Tie the 3 base strings along with the winding yarn from the skein into a knot nearest the windings. Be sure to leave approximately 5" at the end.
- 20) Gently push the windings toward each other to make the lei more compact or tight. The windings should measure approximately 42".
- 21) The lei is nearly complete! \rightarrow Return "completed" lei to the 'Akahi Student Center
- 22) When you're ready to prepare the lei for Song Contest, and with the lei still untied, you will need to TWIST the lei (to give it a nice look), tie the 2 ends together (to close the lei) and add a bow.

 This step will be completed about a week before Song Contest
